This scholarship award program is part of the EWI International Business Career Development Scholarship Program and offers financial support to individuals striving to improve their opportunities through education. EWI was founded in 1938 to provide a networking forum for business women from diverse industries. Since then the organization has grown from a single chapter in the western United States to a world-wide organization. The ASIST Scholarship is a non-discriminatory, educational scholarship program for the benefit of non-traditional students. Single parents, displaced homemakers and individuals just entering the workforce are among those who have benefited from the annual scholarship program.
